Migrant/seasonal Head Start – full day, part year, May – October

CSPP: California State Preschool Program is a part-day educational program for low income or otherwise disadvantaged prekindergarten-age children. 3.5 hours

CCTR: General Child Care funding serving children from birth to 13 years.

APP: Alternative Payment Program

CalWORKS Stage 1 serves birth to 13 for cash aid recipients

CalWORKS 2 & 3 serving birth to 13 year.

CMIG: California Migrant Child Care and Development

ASES: Afterschool Safety and Education Program

CFCC: California Family Child Care

PYPD: Part Year Part Day - 3 and half hours, 4 days per week, 9 months

EYED: Extended Year Extended Day 6 hours, 4 days a week, 11 months

Blended (CSPP): 6 hours per day, 4 days a week, 11 months
